

ORDINANCE #43

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING WITHIN CERTAIN AREAS  
OF THE TOWN OF BOLTON

SECTION 1

NO PARKING: Any person having a vehicle in his charge or under his control shall not cause or permit the same to be parked or left standing upon either side of Huddle Beach Road or either side of Bixby Beach Road within the Town of Bolton between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.

SECTION 2A

When any vehicle is found unattended within the above-described areas and in violation of this Ordinance, said vehicle may be removed, without notice, at the direction of any police officer. After removal of such vehicle, it shall be stored in a suitable place at the expense of the owner. Such owner, or person in charge of the vehicle, may redeem the same upon the payment of all expenses actually and necessarily incurred in effecting such removal.

SECTION 2B

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to the penalty of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each offense.
