AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING WITHIN THE TOWN OF BOLTON

ADOPTED: AUGUST 2, 1988

PUBLISHED: AUGUST 7, 1988

SECTION 1

NO PARKING: Any person having a vehicle in his charge or under his control shall not cause or permit the same to be parked or left standing within the public parking areas owned by the Town of Bolton and situated north of Dula Place (being Municipal Parking Lot #1) and upon the west side of New York State Route 9N (being Municipal Parking Lot #2) (This is the lot between the Ryefield Restaurant and the Hour Glass Shoppe), between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.

A SECTION 2A

When any vehicle is found unattended within the public parking areas described herein and in violation of this ordinance, said vehicle may be removed, without notice, at the direction of any police officer. After removal of such vehicle, it shall be stored in a suitable place at the expense of the owner. Such owner, or person in charge of the vehicle, may redeem the same upon the payment of all expenses actually and necessarily incurred in effecting such removal.

SECTION 2B

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to the penalty of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each offense.
